

TANK TRUCK TEMPORARY WATER METER USES AND PROCEDURES

A STANDARD SIZE TANK TRUCK TEMPORARY METER IS ISSUED ONLY TO PROPERTY OWNER OR OWNER'S AUTHORIZED AGENT. PROPERTY OWNER AGREES TO BE LIABLE FOR PAYMENT FOR ALL WATER USED.

- TEMPORARY SERVICE IS ALLOWED FOR 365 DAYS MAXIMUM. RENEWAL IS ALLOWED ONLY WHEN REQUESTED IN WRITING PRIOR TO THE EXPIRATION DATE. <u>FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE RENEWAL</u> <u>PROCEDURE WILL RESULT IN TERMINATION OF THE AGREEMENT AND REMOVAL OF THE METER.</u> <u>Code of Ordinances - Section 31</u>
- 2. A TEMPORARY TANK TRUCK METER IS DEFINED AS, "WATER SERVICE PROVIDED FOR THE FILLING OF TANKS ON MOTOR VEHICLES TRANSPORTING WATER USED FOR OTHER THAN EARTH GRADING PURPOSES, WHICH SERVICE SHALL BE MADE ONLY THROUGH A PORTABLE METER ISSUED BY THE DISTRICT TO A CUSTOMER SPECIFICALLY FOR USE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS HEREIN FOR SUCH SERVICE." A WATER TRUCK IS DEFINED AS A TRUCK THAT HOLDS WATER ONLY, NO OTHER CHEMICAL MAY BE PRESENT OR A REDUCED PRESSURE BACKFLOW PREVENTION DEVICE IS REQUIRED. Code of Ordinances Section 25
